Eliyahu McLean Rodef Shalom – Pursuer of Peace

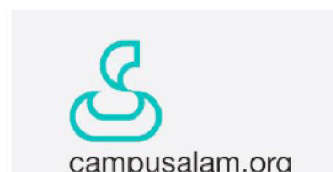

Sheikh Abdul Aziz Bukhari

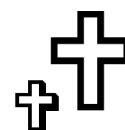
